To monitor, evaluate and feedback on player and team performances. To contribute to coach development within the club. To attend competitions with team and/or players. To maintain high ethical standards in coaching. Ensure that knowledge, skills and qualifications are kept up to date. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold an appropriate coach qualification (UKCC Level 2) Good knowledge and understanding of the sport. Great organisational skills. Confident, with good leadership skills. Ability to communicate with groups of individuals and to delegate. Ability to report on progress to Committee. Hold a current license, insurance, CRB and knowledge of child protection. To maintain professional standards in relationships, including non-discriminatory practices, and to maintain a high level of confidentiality and discretion.
